

**ORDINANCE # 08-2 FOR SLOW-NO-WAKE AREAS
TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO. WI**

A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF THE SPIDER CHAIN OF LAKES AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Town Board of the Town of Spider Lake do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of the Spider Chain of Lakes.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Spider Lake

Section II Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71. Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV Definitions

- (a) "Slow-no-wake means that speed at which a watercraft moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Section V Controlled Area

No person shall operate a watercraft faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of the Spider Chain of

Lakes on the following lakes at the following GPS Readings: Little Spider Lake:N-46-05-734, W-091-13-527; Big Spider Lake: N-46-05-839, W-091-13-209; Fawn Lake Channel N-46-06-604, W-091-13-099 and N-46-06-654, W-091-13-100; Fawn Lake N-46-06-828, W-091-13-060, and North Lake N-46-06-975, W-091-12-951.

Section VI Posting Requirements

The Town of Spider Lake shall place and maintain a copy of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town of Spider Lake pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

Section VII Penalties

Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.


Section VIII Severability



If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.


Section IX Effective Date


This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication or posting as required by law.




